APPROVAL OF THE FORM AND MANNER OF

THE REGISTER OF PARTIES

- 1. This instrument is made pursuant to section 69 of the Electoral Act 2017 (the Act).
- 2. I hereby approve:
 - The Register of Parties (**the register**), containing the names of the parties registered under Part 6 of the Act, the written constitutions of those parties and other particulars or documents required by Part 6 of the Act including:
 - applications for registration of a party made pursuant to section 59 of the Act,
 - applications for amendment of the registered particulars of a party made pursuant to section 66 of the Act, and
 - annual returns for the continued eligibility for registration of a party furnished pursuant to section 67 of the Act.
 - The registered particulars and documents of each registered party are to be kept separately within the register.
 - The register will be kept in paper and electronic form.
 - The register is to include the parties registered under the *Parliamentary Electorates* and *Elections Act 1993* that were registered parties immediately before the commencement of the Electoral Act 2017.
 - The following information and documents in relation to each registered party that is kept on the register is to be published on the New South Wales Electoral Commission's website pursuant to section 70 of the Act:
 - the name of the party
 - the registered abbreviation of the name of the party (if any)
 - the name of the registered officer of the party
 - the name of the deputy registered officer of the party
 - the name of the secretary of the party
 - the address of the party headquarters in New South Wales, and
 - a copy of the registered party's written constitution.
