

# Annual return for continued registration

Use this form to lodge a party's annual return, update the party's constitution where relevant, and amend the list of members upon whom it relies to support its eligibility for continued registration, between 1 June and 30 June each year to remain registered. This form must be completed by the registered officer.

To remain eligible for registration a party must have a written constitution and at least 750 members (100 for a local government party) supported by Declaration of party membership forms matching the electoral roll. Members should check their current enrolment details online at [roll.elections.nsw.gov.au/NSWLookUp](http://roll.elections.nsw.gov.au/NSWLookUp) before completing the **Declaration of party membership form**.

It is strongly recommended that you provide more members than the minimum 750 (or 100 for a local government party) in case some of the members cannot be relied upon for the party's continued registration.

**Privacy** The NSW Electoral Commission has obligations under privacy legislation, including about collecting, managing, and storing personal information. The personal information collected on this form or included in any other documentation, information or evidence you provide in connection with the form will be used by the NSW Electoral Commission to undertake its statutory and administrative functions relating to party registration, including to determine the party's continued eligibility for registration. We may also use it to update your contact details in our records, conduct inquiries to verify the information that you have provided to us or otherwise verify your eligibility, send you relevant notifications or reminders (including via sms or email), provide information about your statutory obligations or invite you to participate in relevant surveys or information seminars. You are required by law to provide the information requested if you wish to remain registered. Not supplying all the information requested may result in the party's registration being cancelled. The information collected is held by the NSW Electoral Commission and is accessible by relevant staff and its contractors. Please note that information contained in this form may be included in the Register of Parties and/or Local Government Register of Political Parties and may be viewed as part of a public inspection of a registered political party's information. If a silent elector provides their address, it will be redacted before the form is made available for inspection. We will disclose your personal information to other persons or entities if we are lawfully authorised or required to, for example, to other relevant investigative agencies for law enforcement purposes.
