Help make sure you and your community are informed about when, where and how to vote in the 2024 NSW Local Government elections.

The NSW Local Government elections are on Saturday, 14 September 2024. **Voting is compulsory.** You are entitled to vote if you are an Australian citizen aged 18 years and over.

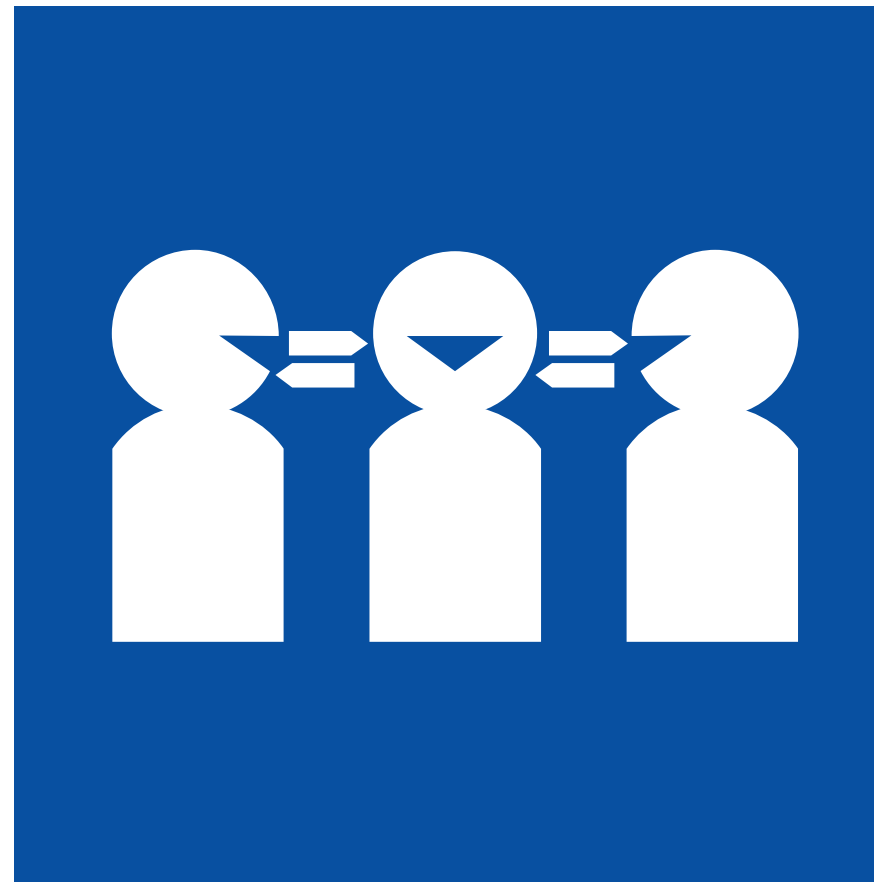

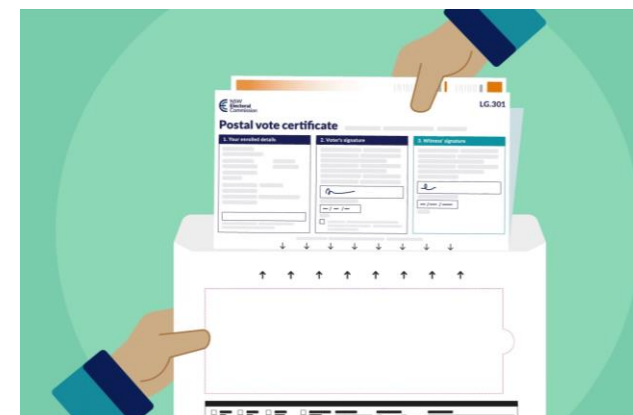
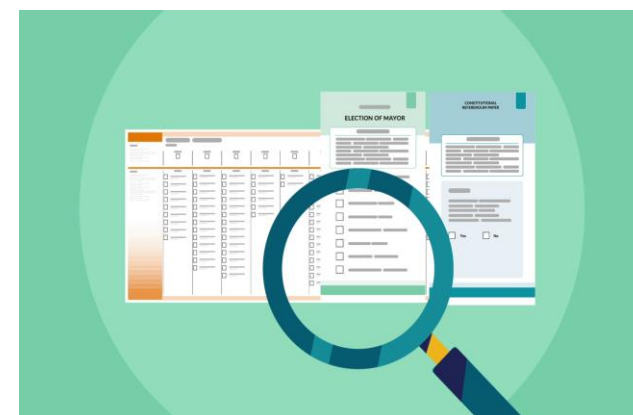
Community resources

Interpreting services

The NSW Electoral Commission works with TIS National to provide language support. Call 131 450 and ask them to call the NSW Electoral Commission 1300 135 736.

Multilingual election officials will be present at many voting centres, wearing badges to indicate the language that they speak.

Polling places will feature display posters with QR codes linking to in-language online resources.
