**APPROVAL OF THE MANNER OF RECORDING A MARK AGAINST A
PERSON'S NAME ON THE AUTHORISED ROLL**

Under section 131 of the *Electoral Act 2017* I approve the manner of recording a mark against a person's name on the authorised roll to show that the person has received a ballot paper.

On the printed authorised roll an election official will draw a single line point-to-point between the arrow heads next to the elector's name.

On the electronic authorised roll an election official will select the election management application command 'Mark off and Accept Vote Retain Search Criteria' or the command 'Mark off and Accept Vote Clear Search Criteria'.
