

## Nil disclosure: half-yearly disclosure of political donations for an elected member (1 January - 30 June 2024)

## Who needs to complete this form

The person responsible for an elected member who is:

- a Member of the NSW Parliament and is a member of a State registered party the party agent.
- a local government councillor or mayor and is a member of a local or State government registered party the elected member OR with mutual agreement the party agent.
- not a member of a registered party the **elected member**.

## What you should use this form for:

Use this form to declare that **no** political donations were received or made, including:

- small political donations (under \$1,000);
- reportable political donations (\$1,000 or more);
- annual or other subscriptions paid to a party;
- contributions, entry fees or other payments to participate in a fundraising venture or function;
- reportable loans (\$1,000 or more); and
- contributions made by the elected member into the campaign account.

## When to submit

Return completed form by **11 August 2024** using the contact details at the bottom of this page. Penalties apply for failing to comply.
