Local Government elections

Once a **Nomination Form (LGBY.202 or LGBY.203)** has been lodged with the Returning Officer, amendments to the details on the lodged Nomination Form may only be made by completing this form. This form must be lodged with the Returning Officer prior to 12 noon on Nomination Day. This form may be lodged by email, post or in person.

Privacy collection notice. NSW Electoral Commission collects information on this form for the purposes of processing nominations, to contact candidates and nominators to send information, reminders or surveys about the election and to support our functions. Our staff and contractors have access to the information in this form. We may disclose this information to third-party providers to carry out our functions, and to others if legally required or authorised. We publish the candidate's name and enrolled suburb, town or locality on our website, and if elected, we provide the candidate's contact details to parliament. If the information required by this form is not provided, we may not be able to process this nomination. This form cannot be amended once lodged. If you need to correct information on this form, contact us. No changes to your nomination can be made after the close of nominations at 12 noon on nomination day.
