Application to amend the Local Government Register of Political Parties

The Electoral Commissioner for New South Wales has received the following application from *Community First Team* to amend the Local Government Register of Political Parties under the provisions of the *Local Government Act 1993*:

- **Change the party's name to *Community First Totally Independent Party***
- **Add an abbreviated party name *CFTI***
- **Replace the party's deputy registered officer *Jessica Bernadette Anderson* with *Warren Anthony Morrison (5 The Grange, Kirkham NSW 2570)***
- **Update the party's written constitution, and**
- **Update the registered party information to include the names of the officers or members of the party responsible for ensuring the party complies with the *Electoral Act 2017* and the *Electoral Funding Act 2018*.**
