

Annual disclosure of reportable political donations for a major political donor (1 July 2023 – 30 June 2024)

Who needs to complete this form

A major political donor is an entity or person (not being a party, elected member, group or candidate) who makes a reportable political donation. This form should be completed by the individual or entity who made the donation.

The following people may be an authorised signatory:

Reportable political donation: is a political donation of \$1,000 or more made by the donor to or for the benefit of a party, elected member, group, candidate, associated entity or third-party campaigner **OR** separate multiple donations from the donor to the same recipient in the same financial year, that when combined total \$1,000 or more.

What needs to be disclosed

This form is to be used for disclosing:

- single monetary or non-monetary donations or gifts that total \$1000 or more;
- multiple donations made during a financial year that total \$1000 or more;
- reportable political donations made at a fundraising venture or function; and
- subscriptions paid to a political party.

When to submit

Return completed form by **11/08/2024**, using the contact details at the bottom of this page. Penalties apply for failing to comply.

All pages of this form need to be submitted, even if there is nothing to disclose on a particular page.

You are required by law to disclose certain political donations to the NSW Electoral Commission and to provide the information requested in this form. There are penalties for failing to disclose political donations or failing to lodge a disclosure as required.

The information collected is held by the NSW Electoral Commission and is accessible by relevant staff and its contractors.

Please note that some of the information in this form, and copies of this form, will be published on the NSW Electoral Commission's website as required by law. Copies or extracts of other documents provided in connection with the disclosure may be provided for public inspection on application.

We will disclose your personal information to other persons or entities if we are lawfully authorised or required to, for example, to other relevant investigative agencies for law enforcement purposes.
