About this report

New South Wales is divided into electoral districts for the purpose of electing members to the Legislative Assembly (the Lower House of the NSW Parliament). At a state general election, voters in each district elect one candidate to represent the electorate in the Legislative Assembly. There are currently 93 electoral districts in New South Wales.

The 2023 NSW State election was conducted on Saturday, 25 March. The Electoral Commissioner's *Report* on the administration of the 2023 NSW State election reflects the respective statutory functions of the Electoral Commissioner under the *Electoral Act* 2017 (Part one) and the Electoral Commission under the *Electoral Funding Act* 2018 (Part two).

This report (Part three) contains information about the contest for each of the 93 electoral districts in New South Wales, including nominated and elected candidates, summary of votes by vote type, staffing and venue numbers. The report was produced following the completion of the multi-voter analysis.

Redistribution of electoral districts

The Constitution Act 1902 requires that each electorate has an approximately equal number of eligible voters. The Constitution Act also requires that electoral district boundaries are reviewed and adjusted over time. This review process is called a redistribution and must take place after every second New South Wales state general election. A redistribution was conducted following the 2019 State election and was completed in 2021.

The <u>final determination</u> of the names and boundaries of electoral districts was made on 12 July 2021. This determination was officially proclaimed on 26 August 2021 by the Governor, Her Excellency the Honourable Margaret Beazley AC KC.

The redistribution came into effect for the 2023 NSW State election and will also apply to the 2027 State election. The main changes to electoral district names and boundaries were as follows:

- The electoral district of Lakemba was abolished.
- The electoral district of Leppington was created.
- Four electoral districts were re-named:
 - Badgerys Creek formerly Mulgoa
 - Kellyville formerly Baulkham Hills
 - Wahroonga formerly Ku-ring-gai
 - Winston Hills formerly Seven Hills.

Voting channels

The voting options (channels) available to electors for the 2023 NSW State election were:

- in-person voting before election day during the early voting period (subject to eligibility)
- by postal vote (subject to eligibility)
- in-person voting on election day
- declared facility voting at appointed venues (an approved hospital, nursing home or convalescent home which is visited by election officials for the purpose of taking votes from residents who are unable to attend a voting centre)

• telephone assisted voting for electors who are blind or have low vision.

Each of the 93 electoral districts in this report includes a graph showing the number of votes cast by vote type for the Legislative Assembly total votes, grouped as follows:

- postal
- ordinary (votes cast at a voting centre on election day, includes silent votes)
- NAMAV (name already marked as voted when an elector attends a voting centre and is found to have their name already marked on the authorised roll as having voted)
- enrolment (votes cast by electors who enrol and vote on the same day, either during the early voting period or on election day)
- early voting (votes cast in person at early voting venues, telephone assisted votes, and votes cast at declared facilities)
- absent (votes cast by electors who were voting outside of their enrolled electoral district).

Notes to this report

Enrolment

Enrolment is taken as at the close of rolls at 6pm on Monday, 6 March 2023. Electoral rolls are 'closed' to facilitate confirmation of candidate/nominator eligibility and to enable the authorised roll to be printed. Electors can still enrol after this date and also enrol and vote on the same day during the voting period.

Participation

Turnout is calculated as total votes/enrolment. Participation is the number of electors who attempted to cast a ballot divided by enrolment. It is different from total votes in that it includes electors who had a declaration vote rejected and removes instances of multiple attempts to vote by an elector.

Apparent failure to vote

The failure to vote process had not been completed at the time of producing this report. The number for Apparent failure to vote notices issued is the initial number of notices sent.


Venue numbers




