Distribution of the Constituency Fund pursuant to Part 5 Division 6 of the Election Funding Act 1981

Under the provisions of the Act, a candidate is eligible to participate in the distribution of the Constituency Fund for a by-election if the candidate is elected, or the total number of first preference votes polled in favour of the candidate is at least 4% of the total number of first preference votes polled in favour of all candidates for the electoral district concerned.

A party is eligible to participate in the distribution of the Constituency Fund for a by-election if the party is a registered party as at Election Day, a candidate claims to be endorsed by the party, and the candidate is elected, or the total number of first preference votes polled in favour of the candidate is at least 4% of the total number of first preference votes polled in favour of all candidates for the electoral district concerned.

No candidate or party is entitled to receive more than half of the funds available for the Electoral District.
